From Age to Age, directed by Andrew Miller, is a 14-voice professional choral ensemble comprised of singers from across Minnesota and beyond. The ensemble performs *a cappella* choral music representing many eras and styles. It features tight harmonies, warm sound, and a careful blend of voices. From Age to Age's primary commitment is to bring beautiful and

inspirational choral music to Minnesota's outstate cities and towns, but especially to rural areas and senior communities often underserved by the choral arts. In addition, From Age to Age couples its choral performance with a commitment to supporting humanitarian organizations that promote lasting and sustainable global change. The ensemble currently supports the *One Acre Fund*, which helps Kenyan and Rwandan families lift themselves out of poverty, and *The Central Asia Institute* ("Three Cups of Tea"), which builds schools in rural areas of Pakistan and Afghanistan, promoting peace through education. From Age to Age is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation. Donations are fully tax deductible.

Andrew Miller is an avid choral conductor, composer, vocalist, and voice teacher. He has performed widely across the state of Minnesota, both chorally and as a bass soloist; and he has conducted public school, community, church, university, and professional choirs, including From Age to Age which he founded in January 2007. In 2006, Miller received a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in vocal music education from Bemidji State University, where he studied choral music with Dr. Bradley Logan and vocal music with Dr. Fulton Gallagher. In 2007/2008 Miller taught K-12 vocal music at Long Prairie/Grey Eagle schools. This spring Miller completed his Masters Degree in Choral Conducting and Composition at Minnesota State University—Mankato. Beginning Fall 2010, he will serve as Director of Choral Studies at Bismarck State College.
